



# 2010 call for candidates

## Available OAHHC Board Seats in 2010

The following seats on the OAHHC Board of Directors are open for election during the annual month-long election scheduled for October 1-31, 2010.

Only in the case of a contested race will an official ballot election take place. Where no contest is realized, the Board of Directors simply ratifies the slate as proposed by the Nominating Committee.

- **Director—Position 2 President-Elect**
- **Director—Position 6 Home Health**
- **Director—Position 7 Hospice**
- **Director—Position 11 HH / IV-DME**

Director representation shall be an owner or employee of a provider member agency. Each director is responsible for ensuring OAHHC's long term financial stability and integrity. Directors ensure that OAHHC fulfills its mission by doing quality work. Board members are required to sign a commitment form upon election detailing a Board members' duty of care, duty of loyalty and duty of candor. Each position will serve a *Three-year term* beginning January 1, 2011.

**Candidates** will have knowledge of history, mission and goals. Knowledge of industry issues, the community and commitment to maintaining a strong organization that is responsive to the membership. Working knowledge of bylaws and policies. Ability to handle OAHHC business with tact, enthusiasm and commitment. Ability to communicate effectively. Ability to motivate committee members. Ability to take responsibility and follow through on assignments. Ability to work well with people individually and in a group.

## Becoming a nominee

There are two (2) ways a person may become a nominee for a Board position:

1. Submit a Candidate Form on your own behalf to the Nominating Committee. Any member in good standing, including current Board members, wishing to be considered for an open OAHHC Board position, should complete the Candidate Form attached with this notice and submit it along with a current vitae identifying their training, education, home care and association experience. **Forms must be received by OAHHC by September 15, 2010.**
2. **OR**—Be nominated by a member peer for a Board position. Nominator must fill out the appropriate section of the Candidate Form along with the nominee. Process follows otherwise as stated above.
